Summer Academy is held at George Mason University's Fairfax and SciTech campuses exposing first generation students to college environments.

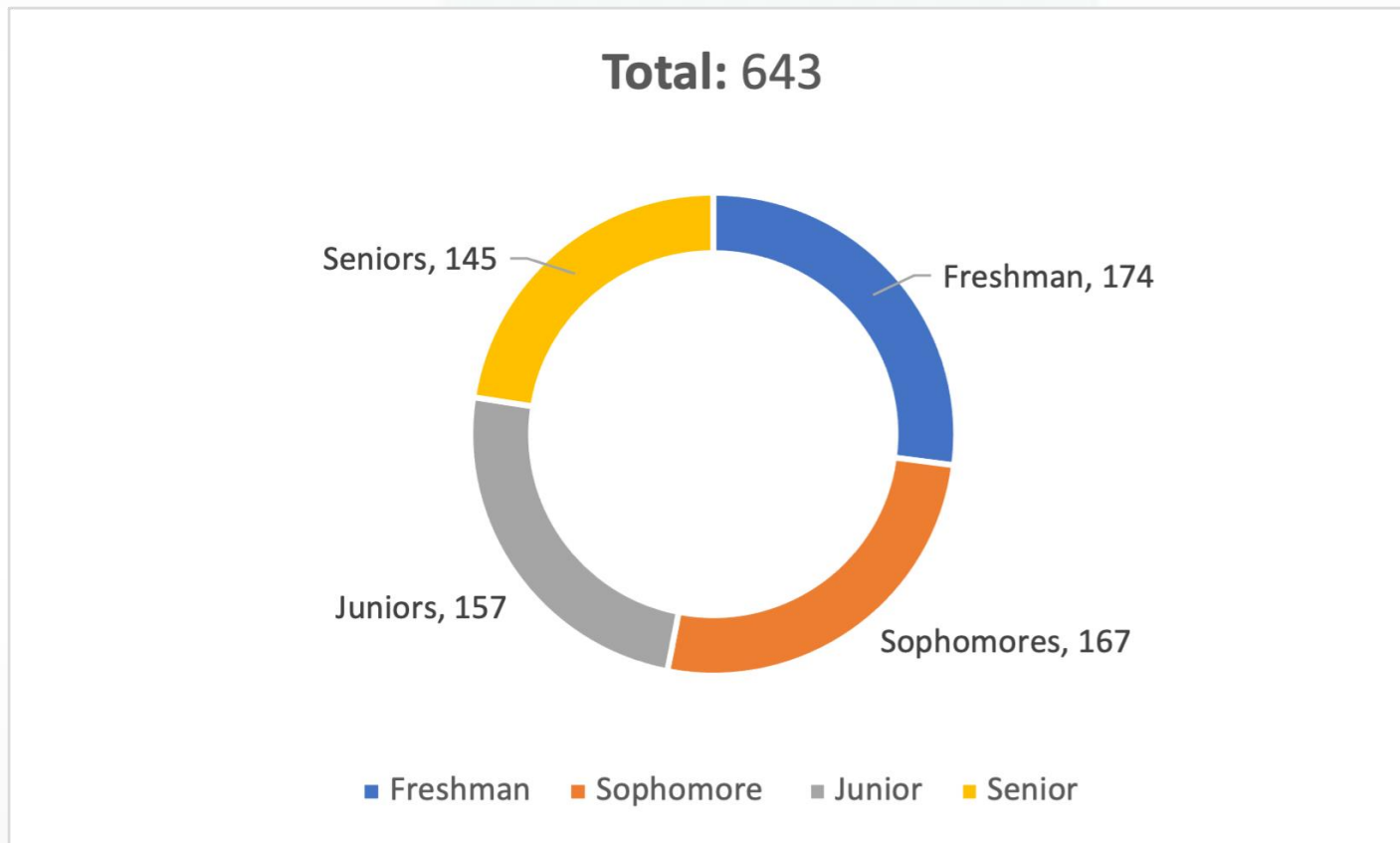

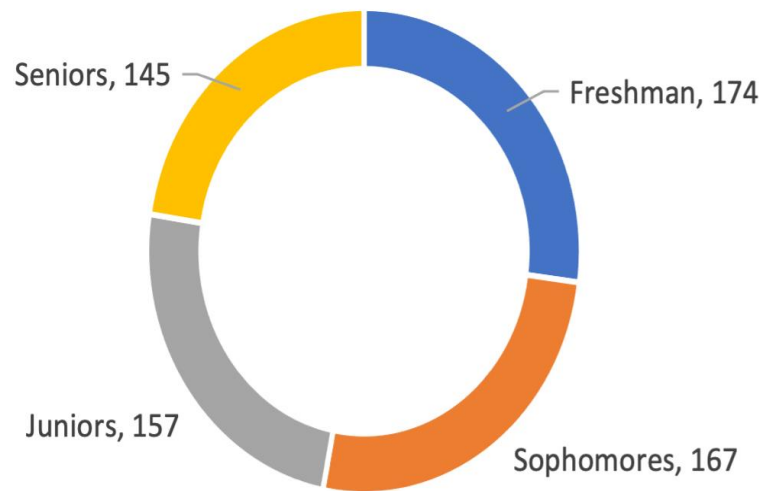
